- Rating, Key wording and Culling images
- Selective Adjustments - New Masking Tools in LR
- Global Adjustments in LR: Basic adjustments, Tone Curve, Colour Grading, Lens Corrections...Sharpening and Noise Reduction, Finishing Touches
- Watermarks and Sizing images
- Photoshop—Curves + Masking, Blend Modes, Adjustment Layers, Selections,...other stuff.
