



### **Display Night Entry Requirements - FOR ALL PHOTO ENTRIES 2023**

**All Members entering photos will be required to upload all their images to the website (details below) including any printed images; maximum file size is 2Mbs. Dimensions 1920 x1200 (one of these must be the maximum)**

Example: Canon full frame cameras resize in landscape to 1800 x 1200 in photoshop, therefore 1200 is the maximum size. If the image is in portrait mode the dimensions would be 800 x 1200, again the maximum size is 1200. If it's a panorama the maximum size will be 1920.

**All images must have a title, no more than 35 characters. Simple titles are best to use. Please do not use "Untitled" or "numbers" ( i.e. Lake Tyrrell 1) .**

#### **Categories**

1. There are 4 categories -Colour, Mono, Mini/Small Print & Digitally Projected Image (DPI)
2. Members can enter from 1 to a **MAXIMUM OF 4 ENTRIES** per Display Night. You can choose whatever combination of categories you wish to enter, and can change combinations every month depending on your own personal favourites, time, printing circumstances, etc.
3. A **Maximum** of 2 entries in any single category is allowed: Colour Prints, B&W/Mono Prints, Small/Mini Prints and Digitally Projected Images (DPI)

E.g. Entries in Open: 1 in Mono print, 2 in colour print and DPI or 2 in small print and 2 in colour. Any combination with a maximum of 2 in a category. If there is a set subject you cannot enter 2 in Open Colour and 2 in Set colour, however you could put 1 in Open Colour and 1 in set colour or 2 in either Open or set. That would be your maximum entry for the colour section.

4. **All Entries** must be entered through our members' link for the appropriate competition via <https://hornsbyheights.myphotoclub.com.au>
5. **Digitally Projected Images (DPI):** All digitally produced entries shall be made from photos taken by the author, there are no restrictions on editing.

6. **Small/Mini Prints:** The Small/Mini Print definitions allow a maximum photo size of 6 x 8in (15cm x 20 cm). This means that you have a choice of any size **up to the maximum of 6 x 8in**. The **maximum mount** size for Small/Mini Prints will remain at 8 x 10in (200mmx250mm). The option of a slightly larger Small/Mini print size may assist with viewing and judging.

#### **Context: Composition - “Getting Your Eye In”**

Mini prints should be the printed image as it comes from the camera with overall/global corrections such as brightness, saturation, contrast, sharpening and white balance only allowed. “Selective” adjustments such as burning, dodging and cloning are **not allowed**. Cropping is allowed. The prints may be produced commercially or on a home printer. Prints that have been “selectively” adjusted should be entered in the Large Colour Print section.

7. **Large Colour and B&W/Mono Prints** have no editing constraints except they must fit within a maximum mount size **no larger** than 40cmx50cm (16in x 20 in). Again it must be all your own work.

**Black & White Prints/Monochrome** can be toned but **not Coloured**. Any hand coloured print or print with a mixture of Black and White and Colour Print material or any Black and White Freestyle Print with a colour element shall be placed in the Colour Print Section. Any digitally produced Black and White Print that retains its monochrome nature can be entered into the Black and White Section as long as any computer manipulation is the work of the author. Prints may be commercially processed, digitally produced, or made in a darkroom.

**All photos must be taken by the author.**

**Large Prints** may be processed by the author, commercially processed, digitally produced, or be Freestyle (contain a Non-photographic Element).

### **Rewards and Point Scoring**

1. Participation Points: Each Open entry =1 point, Each Set Subject entry = 2 points
2. Display Night Award Points: Highly Commended =1 point, Merit = 2 points
3. End of Year Category Winners (Colour, Mono, Small/Mini & DPI) plus Overall Winner: For the most number of Participation Point + Display Night Award Points in each category, plus an overall total winner across all categories.
